2. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCH Regulations are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st Professional of BHMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCH.



The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd, IIIrd and IVth Professionals well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
4. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 13(1) of the HCC Act, 1973 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
