Introduction:

Aarihant Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Institute organized a Blood Donation, Thalassemia Check-up, Eye, and Health Check-up Camp with Orthopedic Consultation on 08/01/2025 at Aarihant homoeopathic hospital. The camp aimed to promote health awareness, encourage blood donation, and provide free health check-ups and orthopedic consultations to the community.

Program Highlights:

Blood Donation(**LIONS CLUB**) : A total of 47 units of blood were collected from voluntary donors. 100 plus people got under Hb testing.

Thalassemia Check-up(INDIAN RED CROSS SOCIETY): 104 people underwent thalassemia screening tests.

Eye Check-up(Dr Urvish Parekh) : 208 people underwent free eye check-ups, and 36 were provided with free spectacles.

Health Check-up: 150 people availed of free health check-ups, including blood pressure, blood sugar, and body mass index (BMI) tests. 6 people are detected with cataract.

Orthopedic Consultation(**Dr Chatur Patel**) : 130 people received free orthopedic consultations and advice from experienced orthopedic specialists.

Participation:

The camp saw an overwhelming response from the community, with 450 plus people participating in the various activities.

Collaboration:

The camp was organized in collaboration with Indian Red Cross society & Lions Club Gandhinagar who provided their expertise and resources.





Outcome:


The camp was a huge success, with the following outcomes:

47 units of blood collected
104 people benefited from free thalassemia screening tests
208 people benefited from free eye and health check-ups
150 people received free orthopedic consultations
Awareness created about the importance of blood donation, thalassemia
prevention, eye care, health check-ups, and orthopedic health
