Objective of the Event

The primary objective of the visit was to provide BHMS students with practical exposure to medico-legal autopsy procedures, thereby enhancing their understanding of forensic medicine. This hands-on experience aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application in medico-legal cases, which is an essential part of the FMT curriculum.

#### Flow of the Event

Arrival and Orientation: Students and faculties from Aarihant Homoeopathic Medical College & RI arrived at the Postmortem Room, BJ Medical College, Ahmedabad at 8:00 am. They were welcomed by the staff and given a brief orientation about the facility and protocols to be followed.

Introduction to Autopsy Procedures: A senior forensic expert explained the objectives and scope of a medico-legal autopsy, including legal aspects, consent, and documentation. Live Demonstration: Students witnessed a live autopsy demonstration conducted by forensic experts. Each step was explained in detail-from external examination to internal examination of thoracic, abdominal, and cranial cavities.

Interactive Session: After the demonstration, an interactive session was conducted, where students raised queries and clarified doubts regarding forensic procedures, identification of injuries, cause of death, and preservation of viscera for chemical analysis.

Concluding Remarks: The forensic team summarized the key learning points, emphasizing the importance of careful observation and documentation in forensic practice and after those students also visited the FMT department of the BJ Medical College.

### Significance / Outcome

Practical Understanding: Students gained first-hand experience in observing autopsy techniques, which helped them understand theoretical concepts more effectively.

Application of Knowledge: The demonstration reinforced classroom learning with real-life applications, particularly in identifying causes of death and medico-legal responsibilities of physicians.

Ethical and Legal Insight: Exposure to ethical and legal protocols followed during a postmortem helped students understand the medico-legal framework in India.

Professional Awareness: The visit also fostered awareness of the role of forensic experts in criminal investigations and public health.

#### Conclusion

The autopsy demonstration at BJ Medical College served as a valuable learning experience for the students of Aarihant Homoeopathic Medical College & RI. It enhanced their understanding of forensic medicine by providing live exposure to medico-legal procedure The visit not only fulfilled the academic requirements of the FMT curriculum but also contributed to the professional development of future homoeopathic practitioners by instilling medico-legal awareness and ethical responsibility.


