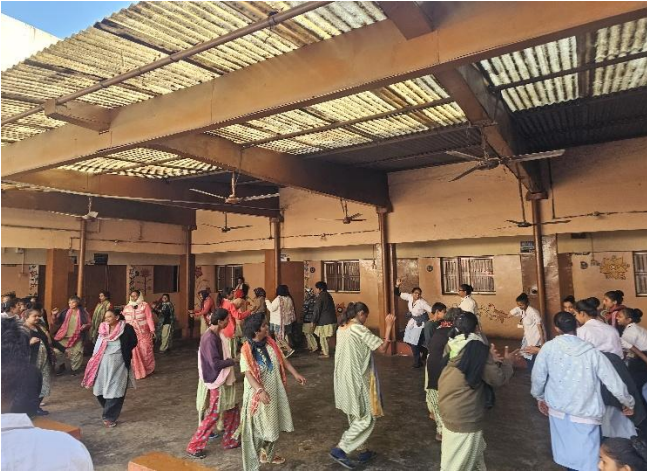
## Conclusion
