**Significance/Outcome:**

1. From this event girls' students and female faculty got information about the basic rights of women and which type of action should be taken if violence of any rights occurs.
2. Our student were empowered regarding-  
Key Fundamental Rights for Indian Daughters

- **Right to Equality:** Articles 14-18 of the Constitution guarantee equal rights and opportunities for all citizens, including daughters, without any discrimination based on sex, caste, or religion <sup>1</sup>.
- **Right to Freedom:** Article 19 of the Constitution ensures freedom of speech, expression, and movement for all citizens, including daughters.
- **Right to Education:** Article 21A of the Constitution guarantees free and compulsory education to all children, including daughters, between the ages of 6 and 14.
- **Right to Protection from Exploitation:** Article 24 of the Constitution prohibits the employment of children, including daughters, in hazardous occupations.
- **Right to Protection from Violence:** The Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, and the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, provide protection to daughters from domestic violence and sexual harassment.

**Conclusion:**

ON 29/01/2025 in the session of fundamental rights of Indian Daughters, Adv. Sonal ma'am gave keen insight related rights of Indian female regarding provision given in Indian Constitution and law for women. She also explained modus operandi of legal procedure to our students. 200 students and 15 faculties attended this session.

The session empowered all the women in its true sense when they learned the gist of their rights from afore mentioned expert session.
